

## PIPE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Machine must be plugged in to a properly grounded outlet.
2. Use only a #10 or #12 3 wire extension cord marked w-a and plugged into a GFIC outlet.
3. Keep all Electrical connections dry.
4. Wear safety glasses, boots and LEATHER gloves. Be aware that any loose clothing, rags, jewelry or long hair could get caught in the machine,
5. The cutting head should be no more than ONE INCH smaller than the pipe size.

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Place the cutting head at least 1 foot into the pipe.
2. Put the motor switch in the forward position and then guide into the line with firm and even pressure.
3. Do not leave too much slack in the line.
4. If the cable starts to bend or twist, stop the machine and unplug it. Rotate the cage in the opposite direction by hand, then push the cable back into the machine 2 feet. Now start over with less pressure on the cable.
5. Keep all bystanders away from the machine during operation.
